



LEAVE NO TRACE ETHICS - BACKCOUNTRY SNOWSPORTS

1. Plan Ahead and Prepare

- Practice Safety First.
- Know where you are going.
- Know your own and your group's limits, and minimize risks.

2. Travel on Durable Surfaces

• Stay on deep snow cover whenever possible.

3. Dispose of Waste Properly

• Pack It In, Pack It Out.

4. Leave What You Find

Leave only tracks.

5. Minimize Campfire and Hut Impacts

- Use a lightweight stove for cooking and enjoy a lantern or headlamp for light.
- Leave huts and cabins in better shape than how you found them.

6. Respect Wildlife

- Observe wildlife from a distance.
- Never feed wildlife or leave food behind to be eaten.
- If you choose to bring your dog keep it under control and do not let it harass wildlife.

7. Be Considerate of Others

- Respect landowners, both public and private.
- Respect other skiers/riders and all other users.
- When ascending trails, keep clear and yield to downhill traffic. When
 descending always stay in control, go one at a time, and slow down near
 others.
- Respect designated areas, signs, and wildlife.
